**APPLICATION FOR STAY**


Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 4-183, the plaintiff, Stephen J. Sedensky III, State's Attorney for the Judicial District of Danbury, applies to this Court for a stay of the Order of the defendant Freedom of Information Commission ("the Commission") regarding the release of 9-1-1 calls from Sandy Hook Elementary School on December 14, 2012 which the plaintiff maintains are exempt from disclosure pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. §§17a-101k(a), 1-210(b)(3)(A) and (B). A Stay of the Commission's Order will ensure that this appeal remains viable and is not moot, and will ensure that

1. Records of child abuse will not be unlawfully disclosed (§17a-101k(a));
2. Victims\witnesses to crimes will not be intimidated 1-210(b)(3)(A); and
3. Statements of victims\witnesses to criminal activity will not be released (1-210(b)(3)(B),

all as set forth more fully in a memorandum of law.
